WHAT IS THE ANNUAL AUCTION: THE 5 W'S

PCA's Annual Auction is a fun event that brings together current PCA families and guests in community and fellowship with each other, with the end goal of raising monies that will allow more children to either join the PCA family or remain a part of it each year.

WHO: You, me, grandparents, friends, coworkers, aunts/uncles, church members.

WHAT: A morning Auction, including a live auctioneer, bidding numbers, catered breakfast for ticket-holders, silent auction, and live auction. Auction items include things like: vacation getaways, theatre and sporting tickets, sports memorabilia, restaurant certificates, complete class-themed gifts such as Outdoor Movie Night; For the Kitchen; Game Night; Children's Library; Outdoor Grilling, and so much more!

WHEN: Saturday, March 16, 2024. THIS IS A SCHEDULED ½-DAY OF SCHOOL FOR ALL STUDENTS. Mark your calendar now.

WHERE: Main Gymnasium and Annex, PCA Campus

WHY: To serve the Lord by serving and blessing our community through giving that enables children to join or remain at PCA who could otherwise not afford to be a part of the PCA family.

HOW: Pray, attend, volunteer, give, sponsor.
