Bob Strodel is the Director Emeritus of Christian Camps and Conferences, Inc. in Alton, NH, the largest Christian camping organization in New England running Camp Brookwoods, Camp Deer Run and Moose River Outpost, where he served as the Executive Director for over 30 years, starting in 1994.



Bob attended Wheaton College in Illinois, holds a Bachelor of Science in Mechanical Engineering from Northeastern University, a Master of Science in Systems Management and a Master of Business Administration from Florida Institute of Technology.

In 1982, Bob started his aerospace career at Lockheed Martin, working on projects such as the Pershing 2 missile, the space shuttle and multiple anti-tank missiles.
