

In addition, off campus cultural immersion trips allow participants great opportunities to shop and try foods and local specialties while enjoying the area's natural beauty.



Academic Excellence

Leadership is strengthened through academic knowledge and investigation. Our academically rigorous program offers:

- Hands on experiments in our state of the art science laboratories
- English language skills training that will build SAT test taking skills
- Robotics program using VEX components
- Classes in computer programming



Athletics

By honing new skills or practicing current skills, students have the opportunity to excel in sports and develop leadership skills on and off the field with their peers.

Fine Arts
