A Fine Arts Diploma will be awarded to students who attend PCA for no less than six semesters and earn a total of 25 credits, as indicated above, with a cumulative unweighted GPA of 3.0 or above as calculated after Semester I of senior year. Also required are the following:

- Complete at least 15 of your 50 service hours each year in arts-related service for at least 3 years.
- Annually participate in yearbook, worship team, or theatre (cast, crew, pit, set design, make-up, costumes, etc.) for at least 3 years.
- In your senior year, present your work in an approved exhibition or performance.

Course descriptions are published in the Course Catalog, available in the Guidance Office and on the school's website.

Expected Course Load

Students at PCA attend for two semesters each school year. The minimum number of credit hours required to graduate from PCA is 22. Students are required to attempt at least 5 credits per year to be considered full-time students.

AP Courses

Students should carefully consider the number of AP courses in which they enroll. Due to the homework load, additional reading and course demands, we suggest students take no more than 3 AP course during an academic year. If a student desires to enroll in more than 3 AP courses they are required to fill out a waiver which will require parent approval and an academic meeting.
